ASTROLOGY AND HEALING

Healers know that a sensitivity to the physical energies and the personal issues of a client can enhance the effectiveness of a healing procedure. Astrology has a special place in both of these areas, crystallizing and objectifying what otherwise can only be intuited by the healer or drawn out in a possibly invasive discussion.

The physical energies are the most basic level to which astrology gives insight. These cannot be grasped simply by knowing the Sun sign of the client, but depend as much on the Moon sign and the Rising Sign (the sign at the eastern horizon at the time of birth). Generally it will be necessary to employ a good astrology program to run the client's natal chart. (This can be had for around \$100.) Sun, Moon and Rising signs taken together give a good indication of the client's vibration, especially as regards speed. A strong Gemini or Aries healer, for example, will have to slow his/her energies down considerably to deal with a predominantly Taurean client, but may find an easy harmony with another Gemini or an Aquarius.

For greater depth of psychological insight it is necessary to perform a more comprehensive study of the client's chart. The

the revelation of personal issues which, after all, are features of the chart, not judgments of the person. The chart gives us permission to be who we are. The healer-astrologer will suggest possible interpretations in a non-judgmental manner. It is helpful to be able to say: "Look here, this is in your chart, given at birth for a purpose. It is how you deal with it that matters."

To acquire a good working knowledge of the client's basic energies one course is sufficient; for comprehensive chart interpretation a second course is needed, after which much further growth comes with the experience of analyzing numerous charts, as well as with further study. For all of its attention to degrees and minutes and angles, astrology is a blend of the objective and the intuitive. The art outweighs the science.

This class is required for the diploma in therapeutic massage. The cost of \$2900 includes a massage table, headrest, sheets, holster, two textbooks and oil. Class size is limited. A deposit of \$100 is required to register.
